Mediterranean Mosaic

Step into a cross-cultural summer where language, service, and relationship-building come together. You'll join our team in helping lead a vibrant English camp for local families, immigrants, and refugees. Through games, conversations, presence, and prayers you'll build real friendships and open doors for deeper connection.

Along the way, you'll explore the rich blend of cultures in southern Spain and spend time in North Africa, learning how language, history, and faith shape daily life on both sides of the Mediterranean. Meet long-term workers, hear their stories, and participate in the ongoing work of hospitality, community care, and creative outreach.

Over 12 days you'll experience hands-on ministry, meaningful relationships, and a glimpse into God's work among diverse peoples. This trip will push you, stretch your faith, and invite you into something bigger.

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Experience Japan

Step into a 10-day vision trip designed for college students who are discerning what a call to missions could look like in one of the world's least-reached nations. You'll move through vibrant Tokyo, historic Nagoya, and the resilient landscapes of Tohoku, learning how culture, religion, and daily life intersect across Japan.

Walk alongside local missionaries and churches serving in these cities to see the realities and opportunities of long-term ministry in a nation where few have heard the gospel.

Meet long-term workers, hear their stories of calling and obedience, and catch a vision for how God might be inviting you into disciple-making of your own.

Over 10 days you'll encounter the people and culture of Japan and begin discerning what God may be calling you to next. This trip will stretch your faith. Come and see how God is at work in Japan.

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Europe with a Purpose

Step into a rhythm of presence over performance, learning what it means to sit at Jesus' feet before rushing to serve. Trade constant doing for intentional being, practicing quiet listening as you explore two countries marked by contrast and courage.

In Cologne, Germany, you'll encounter a city of extremes — home to Germany's largest mosque, Europe's largest brothel, and one of the world's largest Catholic dioceses. Walking its streets, you'll consider what it looks like for faith to take root in places holding both beauty and brokenness.

From there, trace the story of Corrie Ten Boom. Walk through her family's home in Haarlem, Netherlands, where hundreds of Jews found refuge during World War II, then follow the road to the concentration camp outside Berlin where her obedience to Jesus was tested past forgiveness's limits.

Over 10 days you'll learn a different pace of ministry, one rooted in listening before acting. This trip will challenge how you define faithfulness and invite you into something bigger than a single trip — a deeper understanding of what it means to simply be with Jesus."

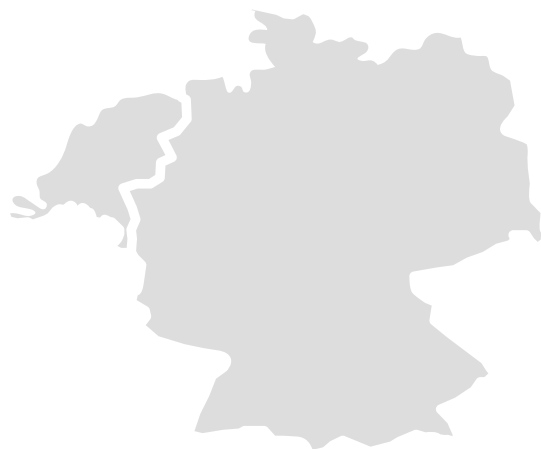

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Southeast Asia Mission Experience

Step into a rich cultural and spiritual landscape as you spend three unforgettable weeks exploring the language, history, and heart of Southeast Asia. Experience firsthand what it takes to begin to learn a new language as you interact daily with locals — observing how they think, live, and relate within this vibrant Asian culture.

Gain insight into Theravada Buddhism and reflect on how a history marked by war and genocide has shaped the nation's present-day society and political realities. Along the way, discover God's global work as you meet long-term workers serving in diverse fields — business, creative arts, trauma-informed care, community development, education, and more. Hear their stories of calling and obedience as they live out disciple-making where God has placed them.

Catch a vision for how you might encounter the realities of the least reached in this region and offer your own gifts in meaningful service alongside the local community.

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Experience Toronto

Step into a cross-cultural weekend or week close to home, engaging four of the world's major religions: Islam, Hinduism, Sikhism, and Buddhism — through the people and leaders who practice them. Over half of the Greater Toronto Area was born outside of Canada, making it one of the most diverse cities in the world.

You'll sit down with religious leaders and community members to learn firsthand how each worldview shapes daily life, and you'll wrestle with how Scripture speaks into these different beliefs. Meet long-term workers serving across these communities, hear their stories of building relationships across faith lines, and gain practical tools for engaging people of other worldviews in your neighbourhoods, workplaces, and social circles.
